Diaries kept by David Barnard of Shelburne, MA, 1884-1886; 1888-1891. Most entries relate to attending school and working on his family's farm on Patten Hill, and include chopping wood, drawing ice, mowing hay and barley, gathering maple sap, shearing sheep, planting and husking corn, planting and digging potatoes, and breeding cattle. There are also a number of entries for road work.
