

Hoyt, Arthur (1811-1890)
Diary, June 7-July 9, 1853

Hoyt, son of Epaphras and Experience Hoyt, became a civil engineer and surveyed the towns of Deerfield, Conway, Northfield, and Hadley in 1830 under a General Court mandate. His first wife was Elizabeth Henry of Halifax, VT. After her death in 1863, he married Mary Ann Jones of Templeton, MA.

Diary consists of entries made by Hoyt while in Illinois laying out the Chicago & Burlington Railroad. Many references to locations visited and work done.
